ADOPTING A CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors has applied for a Community Development Block Grant Emergency Assistance Program (CDBG-EAP) grant for housing rehabilitation.

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Department of Commerce and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) require recipients of Community Development Block Grant Emergency Assistance monies to have in place a Citizen Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Citizen Participation Plan shall encourage citizen participation (especially by persons of low-to moderate-income), provide citizens reasonable and timely access to local meetings and information, provide for technical assistance, provide for public hearings, provide for a complaint procedure and accommodate non-English speaking residents; and


WHEREAS, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors has prepared and publicly reviewed a Citizen Participation Plan.
