**RESOLUTION FOR CONTRACT WITH SW WI WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
BOARD FOR ADRC POSITIONS**

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Commission on Aging acting as the designated Aging, Disability Resource Center (ADRC) has grant funds for the purpose of proving a wide range of Family Care Program services to Iowa County residents;

WHEREAS, Iowa County Commission on Aging has been approved by the State for the following positions:

1. 1.5 Information & Assistance Specialist
2. 1.0 Lead Information and Assistance Specialist
3. 1.0 Disability Benefits Specialist

WHEREAS, Iowa County has been approved to receive 100% state funding for the above positions;

WHEREAS, Iowa County deems it advantageous to contract with the SW WI Workforce Development Board as a means of increasing program flexibility;

WHEREAS, the ADRC program has been incorporated into the 2009 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that the Commission on Aging be authorized to contract with the Southwest WI Workforce Development Board for 1.5 Information & Assistance Specialist, 1.0 Lead Information and Assistance Specialist, and 1.0 Disability Benefit Specialist with funds to come from the State ADRC Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that the contract with the Southwest WI Workforce Development Board for positions will cease upon lack of state funding.
