

Resolution No. 4-1009

DECLARING IOWA COUNTY A PARTNER WITH THE STATE OF WISCONSIN IN PURSUIT OF THE “25 X 25” GOALS FOR ENERGY INDEPENDENCE

WHEREAS, Governor Doyle has created an office of Energy Independence with the goals of:

1. Generating 25% of electricity and transportation fuels from renewable resources by 2025 (“25 x 25”).
2. Capturing 10% of the emerging bio industry and renewable energy market by 2030.
3. Becoming a national leader in groundbreaking energy research; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Energy Independence is seeking partnerships with local units of government in furtherance of the State of Wisconsin’s effort to achieve the “25 x 25” goals; and

WHEREAS, Iowa County should be a leader in setting policies, guidelines, goals and strategic actions that will result in a more sustainable community; and

WHEREAS, Iowa County will benefit from such a partnership with the State of Wisconsin; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby declares itself a partner with the State of Wisconsin in pursuit of the “25 x 25” goals for energy independence; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon adoption, the County Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this resolution to Governor Doyle’s Office and the Wisconsin Office of Energy Independence.
