Whereas, Iowa County wishes to recognize our employees who have honorably served their Country; and


Whereas, an anonymous donor has offered to pay the employee share of health insurance for any honorably discharged Veteran employee of Iowa County who wishes to take November 11th (Veteran's Day) off without pay;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the County Board of Iowa County hereby declares and ordains November 11th, 2010 as Iowa County Veteran's Recognition Day and expresses its gratitude to these men and women; and


Be It Further Resolved that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize current employees as honorably discharged or reserve Veterans, and entitles those persons to take November 11th 2010 off, either with paid leave or as a non-paid day off subject to contract provisions of all labor agreements; and

Be It Further Resolved that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors requests employees and citizens to take time on Veteran's Day to thank Veterans for their service to their Country.
