Resolution Recommending Budget Amendments for Wage/Salary Changes for 2009

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, when the 2009 budget was adopted the management and non-represented hourly employees salaries and wages were not adopted for 2009 and the departments were instructed to budget based on the 2008 salary and wage rates.

WHEREAS, a contingency fund was budgeted in for in the adopted 2009 budget to cover these salary/wage increases.

WHEREAS, the management and non-represented hourly employees did receive a salary/wage increase for 2009 and the Finance Director has calculated the difference along with the increase in benefits for FICA and Medicare, retirement and workers compensation insurance.

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Administrative Services Committee recommends using contingency funds for the adjustments to the salary/wages and fringe benefits which results in the following 2009 budget amendments:
