

Resolution No. 1-0211

IOWA COUNTY EMERGENCY AND/OR DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS on February 1st, 2011 at approximately 6 p.m. a disaster, namely a Winter Storm/Blizzard struck Iowa County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, because of emergency conditions, the County Board was unable to meet with promptness; and

WHEREAS, it was necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare and good order of the county to proclaim that emergency conditions exist; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator took executive action to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Iowa County by enacting a Declaration of a State of Emergency pursuant to W§323 & W§59; and

WHEREAS, the disaster has caused the county to expend, commit and exhaust its pertinent available resources; and

WHEREAS, the county requests State & Federal assistance and advises the State of Wisconsin of our emergency conditions:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Chapter 323 of Wisconsin State Statutes, as the County Board of Iowa County, Wisconsin, we hereby sustain and endorse the emergency actions of the Administrator and staff and declare a condition of disaster and proclaim such a State of Emergency did exist and authorized public safety staff under the direction of the Emergency Management Coordinator to take prudent emergency actions necessary to preserve and protect Public Safety & Health and request emergency assistance from the State and Federal Government.
