**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE
IOWA COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, Iowa County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted multi-hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, Iowa County participated jointly in the planning process with other local units of government within the County to prepare a Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Iowa County hereby adopts the Iowa County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan and that the Iowa County Emergency Management Agency will submit on behalf of the participating municipalities the adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan to the Wisconsin Department of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval.
