

Resolution No. 6-1015

**WHEREAS**, since the late 1960's, Wisconsin Statute 87.30 has required all counties to adopt and administer a floodplain zoning ordinance that, at a minimum, includes the standards the of Wisconsin Administrative Code NR116;

**WHEREAS**, the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) exists in tandem with local floodplain zoning with the purpose of providing federally underwritten flood insurance and requires that minimum standards be imposed on development in the floodplain in order for a community to be eligible for the program;

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has determined that the Wisconsin model floodplain ordinance does not adequately impose the minimum NFIP standards and has directed the WDNR to prepare a new model ordinance with direction that all counties enforce it as minimum floodplain zoning standards;


**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency and WI Department of Natural Resources have also remapped the official floodplain along the Wisconsin River which is required to be adopted by Iowa County;

**WHEREAS**, the Iowa County Planning and Zoning Committee has held numerous public meetings to review the updated floodplain maps and new model ordinance, plus held a public hearing on August 26, 2015;

**WHEREAS**, said Committee is recommending adoption of the new model ordinance;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Iowa County Board of Supervisors hereby rescind ordinance #400.03 and replace it with the Iowa County Floodplain #400.03A.
