

RESOLUTION NO. 9-0517

Transfer of Funds from the Iowa County General Fund to the Fair Association Expense Account for Iowa County Fair Roads

TO THE HONORABLE IOWA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the Iowa County Fair Board approached the Iowa County Highway Department and the Iowa County Public Works Committee with a request to have the County assist with repairs of the roadways on the fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Board requests assistance to repair 1800 LF of Roadways at the fairgrounds and the Highway Commissioner and reviewed the project and recommends pulverizing the existing surface and using hot mix asphalt to complete the road repair and paving for a total estimated cost of \$47,080.00, and;

WHEREAS, at the May 1, 2017 meeting of the Iowa County Public Works committee reviewed the request and the recommendation was to have the Executive Committee review and determine sources of available funding to assist the fair association; and

WHEREAS, at the May 9, 2017 meeting of the Iowa County Executive committee the committee recommended transferring \$23,500 from the Iowa County general fund to assist the Iowa County Fair Association in repairing the roads at the fairgrounds; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Executive Committee does hereby recommend to the Iowa County Board of Supervisors a transfer of funds for \$23,500 from the Iowa County General Fund Balance to assist the Iowa County Fair Association in road repair at the fairgrounds in 2017 in the following 2017 account:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: The Iowa County Board of Supervisors adopts the recommendations of the Executive Committee and approves the transfer of funds from the General Fund balance to assist the Iowa County Fair Association on road repair in 2017.
