

Iowa County ESF-4 Appendix 2

NIMS/ICS Training Guidelines as set by the  
Iowa County Emergency Services Association

March 14, 2012

The Iowa County Emergency Services Association hereby adopts the following NIMS/ICS training guidelines as minimum training for all Iowa County Public Safety Personnel.

1. For all personnel of all disciplines the minimum standard for an agency should be the following:
  - A. Completion of the online courses IS-100, IS-200 and IS-700  
*(courses specific to a discipline are treated that same as the basic course i.e. IS-100 for Law Enforcement.)*

Completion of these courses should occur within the first six months of agency affiliation or the employee/member needs to provide a certificate showing prior completion.

2. For all personnel with Officer Rank: (Lieutenant, Captain, Chief, Assistant Chief, Deputy Chief, Chief Deputy, Sheriff, Sergeant

- A. Completion of classroom IS-300

Completion of IS-300 should occur prior to or within 6 months after becoming a ranking officer.


3. For all Command Officers and Staff: *If your officers, regardless of rank would have the potential of serving as command, then IS-400 should be required of them.*

- A. Completion of classroom IS-400

Completion of IS-400 should occur prior to or within 1 year after becoming a ranking officer.

4. Iowa County Emergency Management will work with Southwest Wisconsin Technical College and/or Wisconsin Emergency Management to make classroom training available for IS-300 and IS-400 annually.

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
