- They may also receive assistance thinking through the available options, and obtain assistance accessing programs and services, as appropriate.

- Transitional Services for Youth with Disabilities is offered free of charge to young adults age 17 years 9 months or older with disabilities, who are seeking guidance and/or assistance in choosing the best options for their individual needs.
