

Alcohol and Other Drug Addiction Program

The AODA program provides confidential, caring treatment to adults and adolescents suffering from chemical dependency. The program offers assessments of drug and alcohol abuse; individual and group therapy for substance abusers and their families; and specialized treatment for adult children of alcoholics and co-dependents. The program also facilitates in-patient treatment and offers aftercare for persons coming out of treatment centers. In addition, the program maintains a 24-hour crisis line, **800-362-5717**, and is a liaison for AA, NA and Ala-Non.

ELIGIBILITY

Am I Eligible? The program is open to all Iowa County residents, including the elderly.

Do I Need Help? Ask yourself the following questions:

- Have my drinking or drug habits caused problems at home?
- Have my drinking or drug habits caused problems at work?
- Have I ever promised myself I'd stop drinking or taking drugs and found myself wanting a "quick one" a couple of days later?
- Do my family and friends keep complaining about my drinking or drug use?

BENEFITS

What Does AODA Offer? The AODA program can help you decide if you (or a family member) may have a problem with chemical dependency. If so, the program can help you or your family member recover from the disease of addiction, and it can assist other family members in recovering from the effects of living with a substance abuser.

What Does AODA Cost? Fees are set on a sliding scale depending on your income and may be waived under appropriate circumstances. Any fees covered by insurance will be billed to your insurance company.
