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**Am I Eligible?** All client-employees of the Hodan Center are eligible to participate in the ABE Program. Enrollment is determined by client interest and input from parents, caregivers, guardians and staff.

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**What Are The Benefits of ABE?** ABE challenges and stimulates cognitive skills through verbal, written and/or computer activities. By keeping participants actively engaged and interested in something outside of their ordinary realm of experience, ABE builds self-esteem and self-confidence.
