

Vocational Rehabilitation Employment Services

The Wisconsin Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) assists individuals with disabilities who wish to obtain, maintain, or improve their employment.

ELIGIBILITY

Am I Eligible For DVR Assistance?

You may be eligible for the DVR program if you have a disability, and you have problems getting or keeping a job specifically because of the disability. Due to limited funds, DVR cannot assist every disabled worker. People with the most severe limitations to work are served first. DVR maintains a waiting list for services.

BENEFITS

What Kinds Of Help Can I Get From DVR?

DVR has many services. Upon admission to the program, you and your counselor will decide which are appropriate for you. Some of the services available are:

- Guidance and counseling;
- Assistance with finding and keeping a job;
- Assistive technology that may enable you to meet certain job requirements; and
- Training for employment opportunities commensurate with your abilities.
