- **Self-help Resource Room.** The Center has books, pamphlets and computer software that will assist you with everything from improving your interviewing skills to creating an effective resume.
- **Special Programs.** The Center offers many free services to individuals who meet certain eligibility guidelines. Services can include funds for training (books, tuition, childcare, transportation), and job search assistance, job referrals and hands-on work experience.
- **Assessment and Testing.** The Center offers a variety of standardized assessment and testing services, including proficiency, aptitude and interest testing.
