

# Supportive Home Care (SHC)

The Supportive Home Care program provides services that enable financially and medically eligible people to remain in their homes. These services include interior home maintenance such as light housekeeping, laundry and shopping, and exterior home maintenance such as lawn mowing and snow shoveling. The program does not provide personal care.

## ELIGIBILITY

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**Am I Eligible?** You may be eligible for supportive care if:

- Your income and liquid assets are below the level set by current block-grant criteria [for details about financial eligibility, call the Social Services Department at 608-930-9801]; **and**
- Your physician states that you cannot perform certain housekeeping and home-maintenance tasks.

## BENEFITS

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**How Can SHC Help Me?** If you can no longer mow your grass, shovel your walk or do your laundry (and you are otherwise eligible), the program could do those chores for you. The goal of the program is to enable you to continue living safely and comfortably in your own home.
