The Elderly Benefit Specialists at Aging and Disability Resource Center Southwest Wisconsin—Iowa County offers information, assistance, and representation to Wisconsin residents age 60 and over with benefit and entitlement programs, such as Social Security, Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Medicare, Medical Assistance, FoodShare, and Family Care.

ELIGIBILITY

Am I Eligible?

You are eligible for Elderly Benefits Counseling if you are age 60 or older.

BENEFITS

What are the benefits of Elderly Benefits Counseling?

- You will receive:
 - Accurate information on public and private benefits and programs;
 - Help determining which benefits and programs you may be entitled to;
 - Help filling out applications for benefits, programs and services;
 - Options about programs or services that might best meet your needs;
 - Assistance with obtaining or retaining benefits and services;
 - Referrals, assistance, and support on other matters including the impact of earnings on financial eligibility for public benefits;
 - In some cases, you may receive representation in formal appeals related to denials of eligibility, termination of benefits or overpayment of public and private benefits.

What Does Disability Benefits Counseling cost?

- Elderly Benefits Counseling is offered free of charge to anyone 60 or older who is seeking guidance and/or assistance in choosing the best options for their individual needs.
