

Family Care Program

The Family Care Program provides funding, care management and services for elderly and disabled adults who are in need of assistance with the activities of daily living. The Family Care Program is available to residents of Iowa County and over the next five years, is designed to eliminate waiting lists for long term care services. There is currently a waitlist for the family care program, but if this is something you or a family member may be interested in , in the near future, contact the ADRC for more information.

ELIGIBILITY

Am I Eligible?

The Family Care Program is available to adults who meet functional and financial eligibility and include frail older adults (65 years or older), people with physical disabilities, and people with Developmental Disabilities (17 years, 9 months or older).

BENEFITS

- In-home services
- Group home or nursing home placement
- Case management
- Improved access to services available

ENROLLMENT

How Can I Enroll?

Contact the Aging and Disability Resource Center Southwest Wisconsin-Iowa County. ADRC staff will gather information regarding the needs of the individual and also financial information. This process may include a home visit and completion of a Functional Screen. Individuals who are eligible will be placed on a waiting list for Family Care.
