

# Community Connections Free Clinic

The Community Connections Free Clinic (CCFC) in Dodgeville offers free basic health care on a walk-in basis to those who are unable to afford or access medical services elsewhere.

## ELIGIBILITY

**Am I Eligible?** CCFC is open to children and adults who are uninsured without regard to age, race, gender or creed.

## BENEFITS

**What Health Care Services Does CCFC Offer?** CCFC offers free, basic medical services such as:

- Medical exams for acute and chronic illnesses;
- Some diagnostic lab and x-rays;
- Follow-up care;
- Referrals to specialists, if needed;
- Assistance with fees for prescriptions ordered by clinic physicians;
- Health education; and
- Referral services to community resources.

**What Services Are Not Provided?** CCFC does not provide:

- Prenatal and obstetrical services;
- Pregnancy and abortion counseling;
- Emergency care such as broken bones and heart attacks;
- Surgery; and
- Payment of prescriptions ordered by physicians outside of the clinic.

**Where Is CCFC And When Is It Open?** CCFC is located in the lower level of the Metropolitan Building, 201 S. Iowa Street in Dodgeville. The entrance is on Fountain Street directly across from the library and City Hall. The clinic is open every Tuesday and Thursday evening from 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. **NO APPOINTMENTS ARE NECESSARY OR SCHEDULED.** This is a walk-in clinic. Patients are seen on a first come/first served basis.
