

HealthCheck (Children)

The HealthCheck program provides preventive health check-ups for children under 21 who are currently eligible for Wisconsin Medicaid or BadgerCare. Based on the outcome of the examination, the program can authorize payment for medically necessary treatments not covered by a child's insurance plan.

ELIGIBILITY

Is My Child Eligible? The program is open to all children under 21 who are eligible for Wisconsin Medicaid or BadgerCare.

BENEFITS

What Are The Benefits Of HealthCheck? HealthCheck offers a thorough physical examination, including a dental checkup and vision and hearing tests. If the examination discloses a need for a treatment that falls outside the scope of existing coverage, HealthCheck can authorize payment for it. HealthCheck meets the physical examination requirements for programs such as Head Start, WIC and school physicals.

APPLICATION
