

## **NEW VACCINATION GUIDELINES**

If your child is Vaccines for Children (VFC) eligible, you can visit the local health department for vaccinations.

Who is VFC eligible?

- Medicaid eligible
- Uninsured
- American Indian or Alaska Native

Underinsured (has health insurance, but the coverage does not include all vaccines or only covers selected vaccines.)

If your child has medical insurance, please make an appointment with your medical provider for vaccinations.

To get immunizations at the Health Department, please call 930-9870 to make an appointment, and your children must be accompanied to the clinic by a parent or guardian, or have a note from a parent and be accompanied by a person over 18 years of age. If you have the children's immunization records, you should bring those with you.

Also, the Iowa County Health Department offers Flu, Hepatitis A and B vaccinations at a cost for adults.
