Unified Community Services offers a wide range of out-patient mental health services, including individual, family, marital, group therapies, and crisis intervention. The program also maintains an emergency line: **800-362-5717**.

Am I Eligible? You are eligible if you live in Iowa or Grant County.

The program offers preventive education, crisis intervention, support, treatment and rehabilitation for you and members of your family. Upon admission, you will receive an assessment and diagnosis, followed by treatment planning. Your treatment plan may include individual or group therapy, and (when appropriate) medication.

Fees for most services are on a sliding scale, based on your ability to pay. In many cases, health insurance, Medical Assistance, or Medicare will cover some or all of the bill. If you live in Grant or Iowa County, service will not be denied if you are unable to pay.
