

Resolution Number: 8-0924

RESOLUTION ADJUSTING FEES FOR ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE IOWA COUNTY MANURE STORAGE AND MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

Whereas, authority is granted to establish construction, abandonment and operation standards for animal waste storage facilities by Sections 59.02, 59.03, 59.70, 92.15 and 92.16 Wisconsin Statutes, and ss. ATCP 50.56 and NR 151.05 Wisconsin Administrative Code;

Whereas, Ordinance No. 400.18, the Iowa County Manure Storage and Management Ordinance, was comprehensively revised and adopted in 2019, and was further revised by Amendatory Ordinance No. 5-0921;

Whereas, the Iowa County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolutions 8-1112, 4-1019, and 7-1021 establishing fees to offset the cost of administration and enforcement of said ordinance;

Whereas, with the support of the Iowa County Land Conservation Committee, the Public Works Committee has taken action to recommend updating these fees to offset program costs to the greatest extent possible, and to make them non-refundable;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the Iowa County Board of Supervisors do hereby adopt this resolution updating permit fees as follows associated with the administration and enforcement of the Iowa County Manure Storage and Management Ordinance:

| Closure or repair of storage structure permit application review fee | \$350 |
| Repurpose of storage structure permit application review fee | \$350 |
| Late fee for Nutrient Management Plan updates and/or checklist submittal | \$50/month |
| After-the-fact permit application review fee | 3 times regular fee |

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these established fees shall be distributed with 80% going to the Iowa County Land Conservation Department and 20% to the Iowa County Office of Planning & Development, except for the late fee for Nutrient Management Plan submittal, of which 100% shall be distributed to the Iowa county Land Conservation Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED all fees as stated in Resolutions 8-1112, 4-1019, and 7-1021 are no longer in effect.
