Clinical Care & Prevention

- Free blood pressure & weight checks
- · Free adult vaccines: uninsured or underinsured
 - Restrictions apply, call for details
 - Currently, tetanus vaccines are free regardless of insurance status
 - Homebound vaccinations
- Free childhood vaccines to children through 18 years of age who:
 - Do not have insurance that pays for immunizations, or
 - Have Medical Assistance or BadgerCare, or
 - Are Native American or Alaskan Native.
- TB skin tests \$35 per test
- Free harm reduction supplies in Public Health Vending Machines
 - Located at 303 W. Chapel St in Dodgeville & 345 W. St, Arena.
 - Free supplies include NARCAN, fentanyl test strip kits, condoms, pregnancy tests, emergency blankets, gun locks, dental kits, hygiene kits, COVID tests, CPR masks, medication disposal bags, etc.

Communicable Disease

- Communicable disease case investigation & education
- Tuberculosis medication management

Maternal & Child Health

- Prenatal and post-partum home visits
 - Free infant weight checks
 - Connection to resources & education
- Free well water test kits for those who are pregnant or have a child under the age of 1 year
- Offer free pack n plays and infant necessities for those in need
 - Connection to free car seat and safety checks
- Free blood lead capillary testing for children - restrictions apply, call for details

Environmental

- Well water testing lab pick up testing bottles M-F between 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m.
 - Bacteria \$35
 - Nitrates \$35
 - Lead \$35
 - Arsenic \$35
- No-cost well water testing is available for individuals with a financial or other burden and the well serves: a pregnant person, or a child (under the age of 12), or a person with a weakened immune system.
- Free radon test kits
- Human health hazard investigation
- Free HEPA vacuum rental
- Rabies control
